COMMENDATIONS

- Danny Tapia, Park View student, participated in the official ceremony to open the “State of the Art’ exhibition at Union Station in Washington D.C. on June 8, 2010. Children with disabilities from around the country as well as Ambassador Jean Kennedy Smith presided over this exciting event.
- Additional student artwork was displayed throughout the month of July at Bells and Whistles Snackery in Glen Ellyn and the list of contributing artists was commended.

CONSENT AGENDA – The consent agenda was revised and then approved as amended.

DISCUSSION ITEMSA

- Legat Architects reported on the “Flip This Classroom” project. In October, the Glen Crest Reading lab will be recreated with many new features including carpeting, moveable furniture, lighting, and sound system. The project blends best practices in learning styles research with physical accommodations to the classroom. This pilot is made possible by partnerships and donations from vendors.
- Director of Maintenance Tim Tomazin’s report provided detailed information on the energy management system, and the improved technology and control ability that was provided from the referendum construction projects. Cost effective green solutions to the overall utility functions were highlighted.
