Todd Schrage Named New Principal at Glen Crest Middle School Schrage to Replace Dr. Scott Stevens, who will Retire on June 30

GLEN ELLYN- District 89 Board of Education members voted unanimously February 23 to hire Todd Schrage as the new principal for Glen Ellyn’s Glen Crest Middle School.

Schrage is currently employed as the Assistant Principal at Glen Crest Middle School, a position he has held for the last 10 years. Prior to becoming Glen Crest’s Assistant Principal, Schrage taught 6th and 7th grade science at Glen Crest and 4th grade at Arbor View Elementary School in District 89.

“Due to his experience as Glen Crest’s Assistant Principal, Todd will provide a seamless transition of leadership,” said Superintendent Dr. John S. Perdue. “He will also provide visionary leadership that encompasses the best practices in middle level education.”

Schrage earned a Bachelors Degree in Elementary Education with an emphasis on Biology and Environmental Science from the University of Wisconsin at Whitewater, and a Masters Degree in Educational Administration from Northern Illinois University.

“I am passionate about middle school level education and am excited about this new opportunity,” said Schrage. “One of my professional desires is to help create a more positive and inviting learning atmosphere for students. In addition, my vision for Glen Crest is for our staff to explore every way possible to improve how we reach students on a personal level, and how we support their academic growth.”

Schrage will replace outgoing Glen Crest Principal Dr. Scott Stevens, who will retire on June 30. Stevens has served as Glen Crest Middle School’s principal for 15 years and prior to becoming the building’s principal he served as an assistant principal and counselor in neighboring District 41.
