The Dental Health Program at DuPage County Health Department provides access to dental services and oral health education for low income residents of DuPage County. The goal of the Dental Health Program is to improve oral health of DuPage County residents, allowing them to be successful in school, employment and other areas of their lives.

Dental Clinic

- Appointments are required for all dental services.
- Dental treatment and referrals provided based on individual needs.
- Clients must provide proof of income to determine qualification for dental services.
- Low cost fees are charged per services.

• If a client has Medicaid, dental services will be billed to their plan.

- Dental Care Connections links residents to community dental providers for services at a reduced rate.
- "Ready, Set, Smile" Clinic monthly clinic for children 0 – 5 years old and children with special healthcare needs.
