## Do I Qualify?

## To qualify, you must meet the following guidelines:

- Must be uninsured (cannot currently be enrolled in private or public insurance, including Medicare, Medicaid, employers sponsored, ACA Marketplace)
- Must meet program income guidelines (See Chart)

FAQ's

I have Access DuPage. Can I use the DuPage Dispensary of Hope?

Using our new free pharmacy program is easy for AD members; you automatically qualify! Just bring your Access DuPage card with you to the pharmacy.

How much medication can I receive per visit?

The DuPage Dispensary of Hope can provide up to 90 days of medication per visit, with a valid prescription.

What if only some of my medications are available for free at the DuPage Dispensary of Hope Pharmacy?

DuPage Care Center's Outpatient Pharmacy is a full service pharmacy. This means that in addition to the free medications available through DuPage Dispensary of Hope, other medicine is also available for retail purchase.

How do I get my prescriptions to the DuPage Dispensary of Hope?

- 1. Ask your doctor's office for a new paper prescription and bring it to DDOH.
- 2. Ask your doctor to send a prescription to DDOH by fax or via Surescripts.
- 3. Call your current pharmacy and have them transfer your prescription to DDOH.
- 4. Contact DDOH and tell them you'd like to have your medication transferred.
