	<b>OPTION 1</b> : Some improvements including security (98%), roofing (58%), mechanical systems
	(48%), electrical & plumbing (12%), doors & windows (2%), furniture, fixtures & equipment (4%),
	pavement & sidewalks (10%).
	Estimated cost: \$13 million   Approximate yearly tax decrease: \$139
	<b>OPTION 2:</b> More improvements including security (100%), roofing (61%), mechanical systems
	(77%), electrical & plumbing (33%), doors & windows (17%), furniture, fixtures & equipment
	(15%), outdoor improvements (5%), pavement & sidewalks (13%), and flooring (4%).
	Estimated cost: \$20 million   Approximate yearly tax decrease: \$51
	<b>OPTION 3:</b> Most improvements including security (100%), roofing (65%), mechanical systems
	(82%), electrical & plumbing (40%), doors & windows (49%), furniture, fixtures & equipment
	(16%), basic renovations (20%), outdoor improvements (5%), pavement & sidewalks (72%), and
	flooring (4%).
	Estimated cost: \$27 million   Approximate yearly tax decrease: \$4
