1. When seeing the "Unauthorized Error 401" message in Chrome, open Settings.



2. Select "Sign in to Chrome", or, if the incorrect account is signed in, select "Choose Another Account"



3. Confirm this is the correct account. If it is not, select the down arrow and choose the correct one. Once the correct account is chosen, select the "Yes, I'm in" button.
