Tonight's Objectives

The "WHY" behind our work

- Increase in administrative transfers over the past 8 years, resulting in:
 - Lost instructional minutes for students
 - Increase of students from same neighborhood attending different schools
 - Increase in transportation costs
- Park View Elementary would be over capacity with current assigned boundary area if all students attended their assigned school
 - Currently, 535 students requiring 22 regular-education self-contained classrooms, live in the current Park View attendance area. Park View has 21 regular-sized classrooms.
 - 40+ students a year are being administratively transferred from Park View to other district schools
- Fiscal responsibility
 - Evaluate all operating costs/expenses to evaluate any needed changes



Impact on adding FTE to the budget

Each 1.0 full-time equivalent / teacher (FTE) added to the budget is an additional:


\$60,000 in expenses PER YEAR **or**

\$300,000 over 5 years

With Kasarda Series B projections, staffing is predicted to increase 10.4 FTE in the next 5 years

Cumulative cost of 10.4 additional FTE through 2021-22 is \$2.3 million

Current Boundaries



Current boundaries

- 106 administrative transfers
 - Resulting in approximately 60 additional minutes on the bus daily
- \$2.3 million additional personnel cost over 5 years based on Kasarda report (included in financial projections)






First Floor Plan






First & Second Floor Plans









- \$1,068,733 additional personnel cost over 5-year projection











- \$1,179,649 additional personnel cost over 5-year projection






First & Second Floor Plans





*All maps show sample room assignments, actual assignments are made at the building level



Discussion

Evaluate options based on:

- Best for all students
- Aligned to District Strategic Plan
- Minimal disruption
- Reduces administrative transfers
- Fiscally responsible
- Maximizes utilization of current buildings long term
- Sustainable



Additional information

- Current 4th graders will have the option to stay at current attending school.
 - There will be a two-week time period once Board decision is finalized to make request
 - Parents will provide transportation
 - Siblings not guaranteed spot
- Students on open boundary will need to reapply
- Students who have been administrative transferred will be assigned to home school, open boundary can be requested



Transition Planning

- All elementary buildings are working on welcoming activities
 - Welcome letters from principal
 - Welcome nights with building tours
 - Peer buddy
 - Pen pals with new classmates
 - Mentor families
 - Families with like age children partnered for welcoming and transition
 - Spirit wear "swap"
 - Playground days over the summer
