**CONSENT AGENDA** – The consent agenda was approved as presented.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

**IASB Delegate Assembly Resolutions** (*BOE Goals: Continuous improvement and changing financial needs*).

The Board reviewed several resolutions from the 2021 Resolutions, which will be adopted at the IASB's Delegate Assembly during the Joint Annual IASB/IASA/IASBO Conference, November 19-21, 2021. The board's top priority is to maintain school safety and to ensure that our local school district Board of Education maintains local control.

**Report on Building School Improvement Plans** (*BOE Goals: Changing financial needs and collaborative and inclusive culture*). There was an overview of building school improvement plans. Each principal highlighted one aspect of their school improvement plan.

- Arbor View Elementary School - Principal Emily Burnett highlighted guided-reading strategies.
- Briar Glen Elementary School - Principal Mitch Dubinsky discussed how opportunities for authentic learning through real-world applications are applied.
- Glen Crest Middle School - Principal Kim Price and her staff are focused on building a multi-tiered system of support that provides individualized attention to the academic and social-emotional needs of every single student.
- Park View Elementary School - Principal Kristie Mate is ensuring grade-level teams have dedicated time set aside to examine student data and share instructional strategies that will help every single student succeed.
- Westfield School - Principal Matt McDonald uses daily morning meetings as an opportunity for students to practice academic skill and check in on social-emotional needs.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT** - Superintendent Tammaru's report included information regarding the following:
