DISCUSSION ITEMS

Challenge program evaluation timeline for 2023-2024. (BOE Goal: Continuous Improvement). Dr. Kingsfield presented an overview of the timeline and process for the Challenge Program audit. The Challenge program in D89 is an extension program for identified students in second through fifth grade. Students can be part of the language arts and humanities strand and/or the science, technology, math and engineering strand. D89 will conduct a comprehensive evaluation of the district's Challenge program during the 2023-2024 school year. The purpose of the Challenge Program evaluation is to understand the strengths and opportunities for growth of the program. The evaluation will include Challenge and non-Challenge teachers, students, families, and outside experts in gifted education. The outcome will be a stronger program that meets the needs of each learner.
