

# The Affordable Connectivity Program

Did you know that you might qualify for free internet service through the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)?

The ACP is a federal benefit program that provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service.



**You are eligible for the ACP if you or a household member meets at least one of these criteria:**

- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income internet program
- Participates in one of these assistance programs:
  - The National School Lunch Program or the School Breakfast Program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision
  - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
  - Medicaid
  - Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits
  - SNAP
  - WIC
  - Medicaid
  - Lifeline
  - Federal Public Housing Assistance

**If you or a member of your household does not meet one of the above criteria, you may still be eligible if your income is 200% or less than the Federal Poverty Guidelines:**

Household Size	Household Income
1	\$27,180
2	\$36,620
3	\$46,060
4	\$55,500
5	\$64,940
6	\$74,380
7	\$83,820
8	\$93,260

For each additional person, add: \$9,440

**Two Steps to Enroll:**

Go to [AffordableConnectivity.gov](https://AffordableConnectivity.gov) to submit an application or print out a mail-in application.
- 02

Contact your preferred participating provider\* to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

Eligible households must both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.

\*Some providers may have an alternative application that they will ask you to complete.
