

Human Sexuality Terminology

- Sexual orientation: **attraction** to others.
- Sex: biological anatomical parts that one is **born with** (female & male)
- Gender: personal identification



LGBTQ+


Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer



- **Lesbian-** non male attracted to a non male.
- **Gay-** non female attracted to a non female.
- **Bisexual-** a person who is attracted to more than one gender.
- **Transgender-** identity that is different than assigned at birth.
- **Queer-** discovering and exploring orientation, identify, and expression.

Cisgender- personal identity and gender correlate with birth sex.







