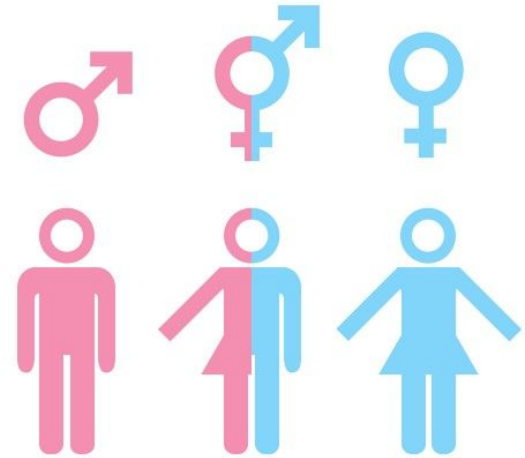

# Human Sexuality Terminology

- Sexual orientation: **attraction** to others.
- Sex: biological anatomical parts that one is **born with** (female & male)
- Gender: personal **identification**



# LGBTQ+

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer

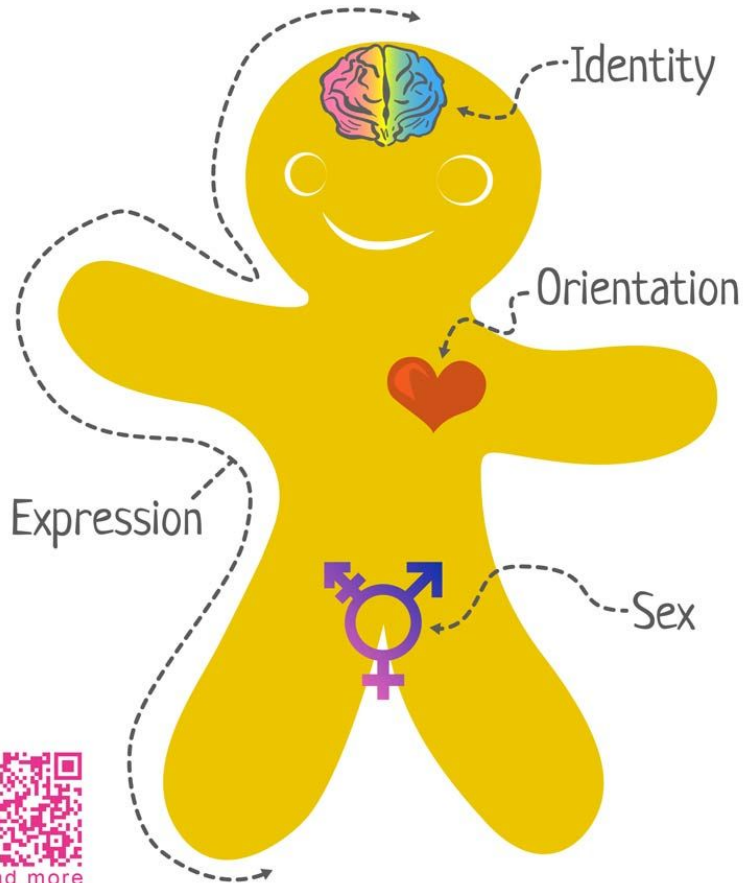


- **Lesbian**- non male attracted to a non male.
- **Gay**- non female attracted to a non female.
- **Bisexual**- a person who is attracted to more than one gender.
- **Transgender**- identity that is different than assigned at birth.
- **Queer**- discovering and exploring orientation, identify, and expression.

**Cisgender**- personal identity and gender correlate with birth sex.

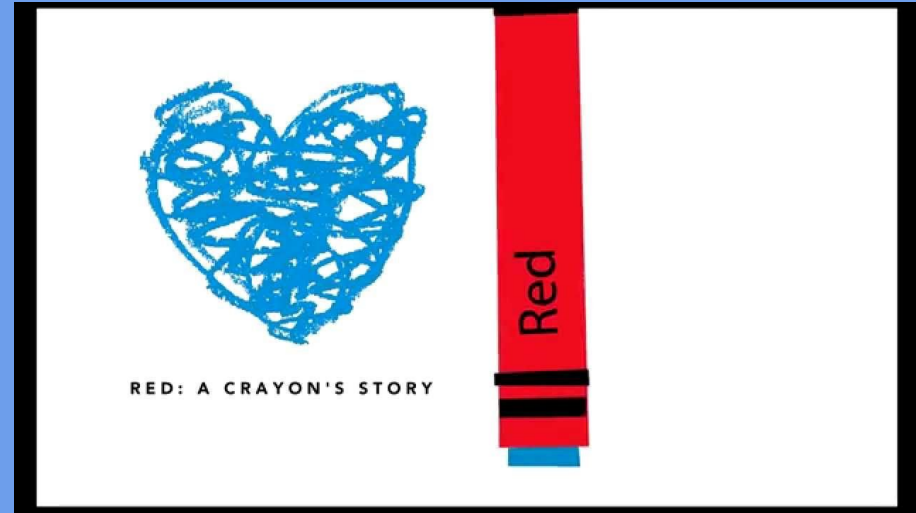
Sexual orientation is who you are physically, spiritually, and emotionally attracted to, based on their sex/gender in relation to your own.

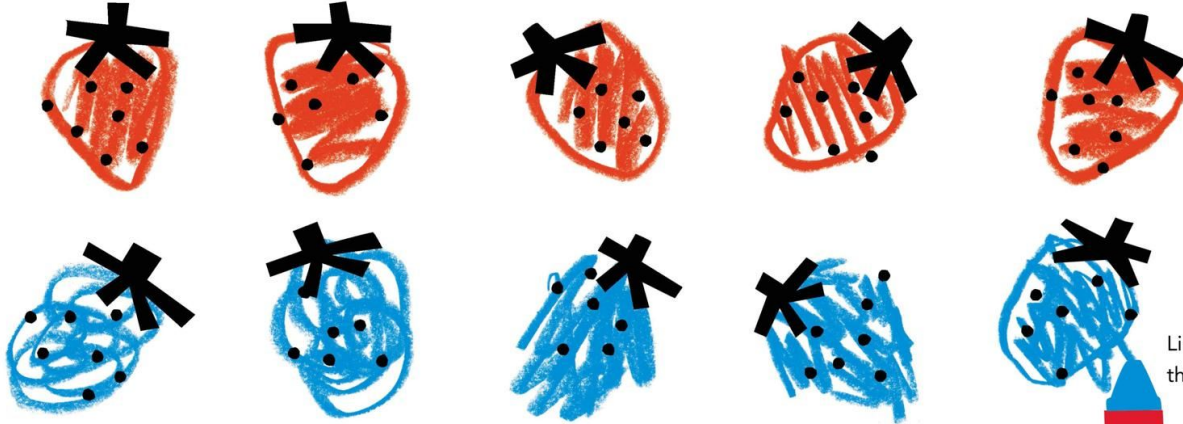

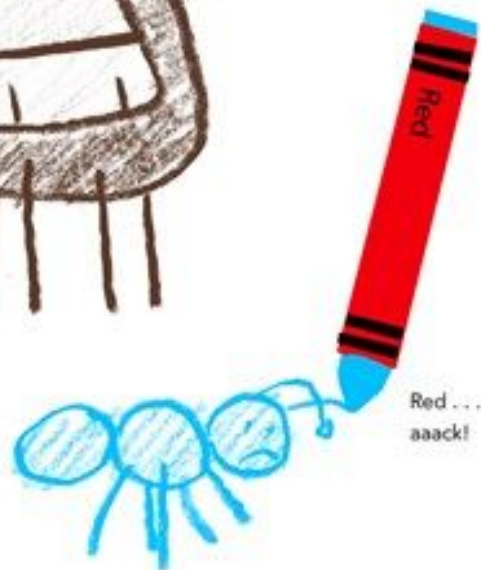

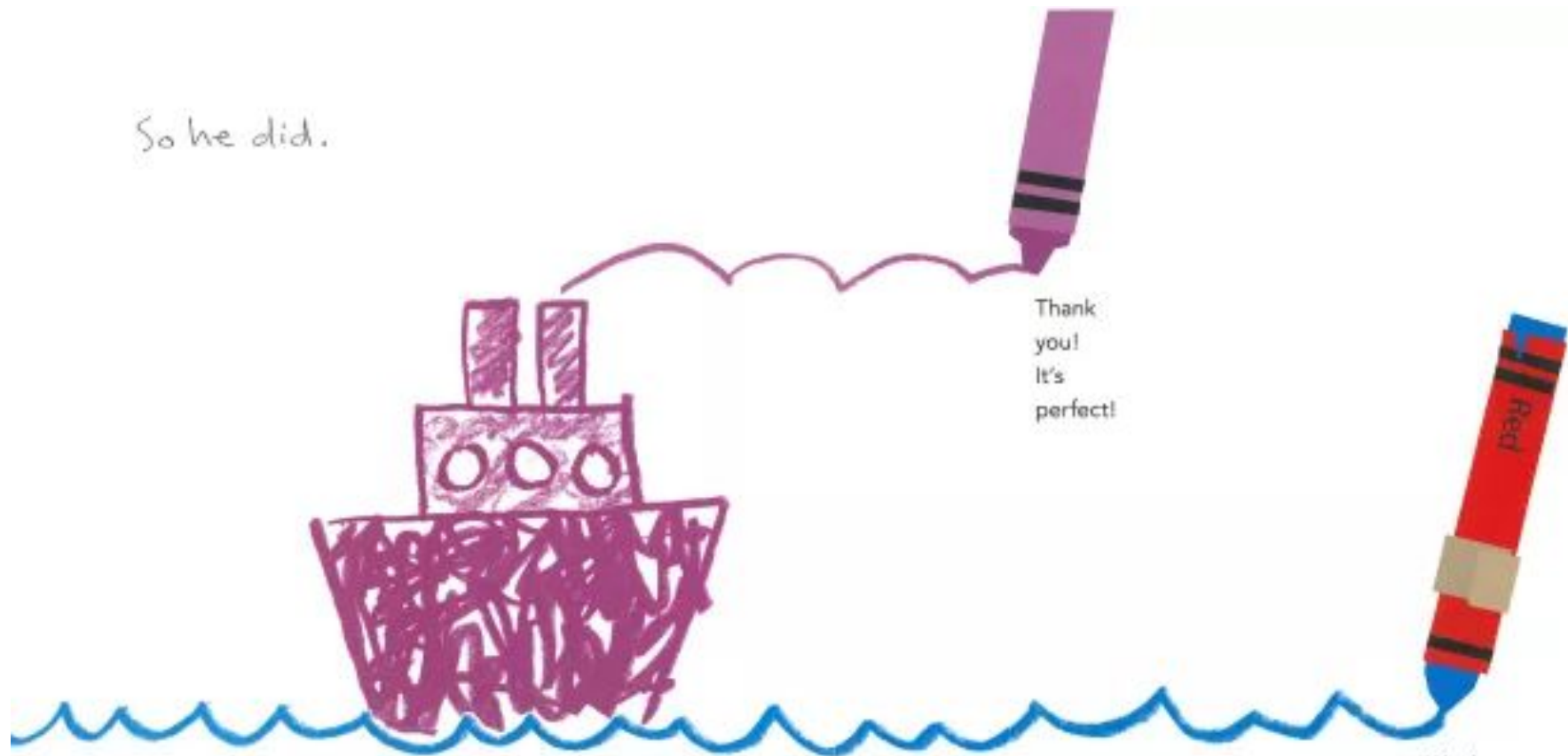
