BOARD HIGHLIGHTS - FEBRUARY 26, 2024 MEETING - 7:00PM

Consent Agenda – The consent agenda was approved as presented.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

- <u>Legislative Education Network of DuPage (LEND) Update</u> (BOE Goal: Continuous Improvement). Peg Agnos, Executive LEND Director and Jennifer Figurelli, gave an update on legislation and other current topics from Springfield. The Governor's K-12 budget highlighted Evidence-based funding with \$350M that include \$50M in property tax relief grants and \$3M for a new Statewide Literacy Plan. There is also a proposed \$75M increase in Early Childhood Block Grant. The Governor's proposal also encouraged a review and adjustment of the Tier 2 pensionable earning cap to the Social Security Wage Base for employees not coordinated with Social Security.
- <u>Audit Report</u> (BOE Goals: Changing financial needs). Cynthia Park from Baker Tilly provided an overview of the 2023 audit. Baker Tilly LLP confirms to the best of their knowledge and belief that the financial statements are fairly presented in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted and all material transactions have been recorded in the accounting records and are reflected in the financial statements.
- Financial Projections (BOE Goals: Changing financial needs and collaborative and inclusive culture). Assistant Superintendent Jones reviewed the District's financial projections, as well as a discussion regarding long-term financial planning. The District's 2023-24 revenue adjustments included a \$235K increase in investment income, a \$50K increase in the National School Lunch program and a \$50K increase in the IDEA Grant due to unexpended funds from the prior year. Revenue assumptions regarding property tax revenue: new property \$3.2M for levy year 2024 and \$2.5M for levy year 2025 through 2028 and an equalized assessed value of 3.0 per year.
- 2024-2025 Board Meeting Dates The Board of Education meeting dates for 2024-25 were reviewed.
